Gustavus, AK (April 06, 2010) > Visitors seeking a worry-free visit to Alaska's Glacier Bay National Park & Preserve this summer can now book an all-inclusive package that covers their room, tours and food for one low price. Glacier Bay Lodge & Tours, managed by ARAMARK Parks and Destinations, is offering a complete two-day, two-night package to visit this World Heritage Site for just \$467.50 per person (based on double occupancy and not including taxes and fees). In addition to enjoying two nights in a standard room at Glacier Bay Lodge, visitors will receive all of their meals plus a full-day boat tour "up bay" to the face of Grand Pacific and Margerie Glaciers – all for less than \$235 per day for each person. Glacier Bay Lodge is the only commercial overnight accommodation located within Glacier Bay National Park & Preserve. The 56-room lodge is nestled among Sitka spruce on the shores of

Bartlett Cove, a short drive from the Gustavus airport which features connections from Juneau, Haines and Skagway.

The lobby features a fireplace, giant wood beams and cathedral ceilings, with guest rooms separate from the main lodge and accessible by boardwalks. Each room features a private bath and/or shower. Two rooms are handicap-accessible. The lodge features a gift shop with sundries and snacks, along with baggage storage for campers. An additional charge applies for more than two persons per room, or travelers on their own.

The highlight of any visit to Glacier Bay is a day spent cruising to the face of the Margerie and Grand Pacific Glaciers, two of the many tidewater glaciers found in the National Park. A National Park Service Ranger provides information and answers questions throughout the cruise.

Guests get an intimate view of marine and coastal wildlife along side massive glaciers and towering mountains on the 79-foot high-speed catamaran "Fairweather Express II (FXII)." The boat disembarks everyday from the dock at Glacier Bay Lodge on Bartlett Cove. Passengers board at 7 a.m., depart at 7:30 a.m. and return around 3:30 p.m. daily.

Glacier Bay, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, is located just outside of Gustavus, Alaska, 60 miles west of Juneau. The 3.3-million acre park is home to magnificent blue tidewater glaciers, towering snow-capped mountains, abundant and diverse wildlife, lush temperate rainforest and pristine ocean waters. The park provides opportunities to observe the ebb and flow of majestic glaciers and is a watery paradise for outdoor adventure-seekers, offering everything from whale watching to kayaking and backcountry exploring.
